NOVEMBER COMMEMORATIONS

From 15 October, come and place your poppy on the 'River of Remembrance' which stretches from the Knightbridge Library balcony to the Cathedral's military St Peter's Chapel. Poppies will be available (donations to the Royal British Legion). Come and be part of this city commemoration of the centenary of the end of World War One.

On 11 November at 6am, every Cathedral in the country will have a piper playing 'Battle's Over' to commemorate this centenary year.

At Chelmsford, the piper will play from the top of the tower and this will be followed by a short service of remembrance. Alongside the usual 9.30am Sunday service and the civic



commemoration at 11am, the Cathedral will be showing 'All Quiet on the Western Front' – a film that portrays the realistic and harrowing account of warfare in World War One and which won the Academy Award for Outstanding Production and Best Director. This is a free event and starts at 5pm.

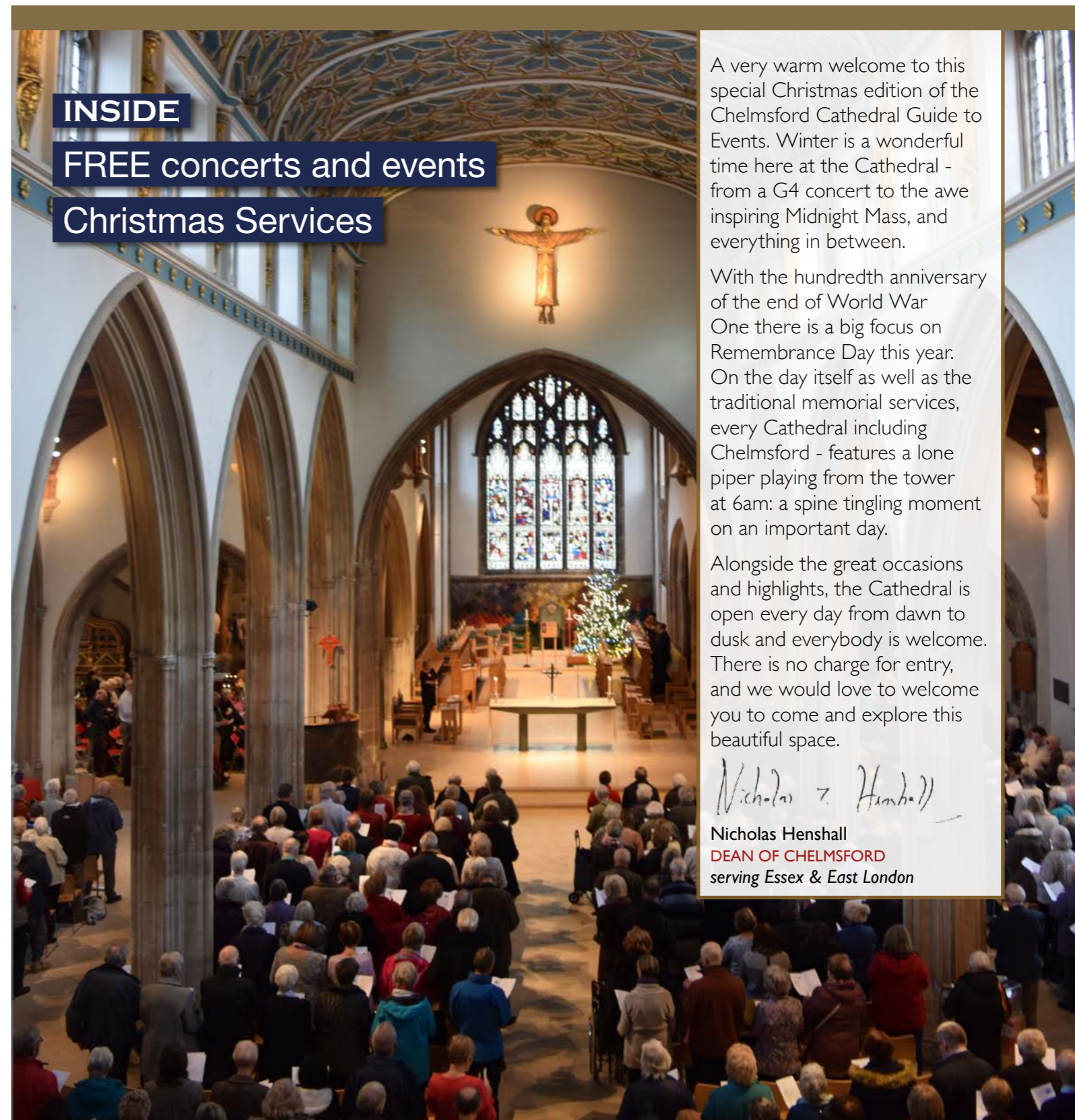
