Chelmsford Cathedral Choirs

The Cathedral Choir is a choir of eighteen boy choristers and twelve gentlemen whose prime responsibility is to maintain the pattern of regular choral services.

The Cathedral Consort is a choir of fourteen girl choristers originally formed to complement the Cathedral Choir by singing services outside of the weekly routine. Presently they sing a girls' voices Choral Evensong on Tuesdays, and sing with the men of the Cathedral Choir on regular occasions throughout the year

The Cathedral Voluntary Choir of adult singers provides the music at many of the services during the year when the Cathedral Choir and Consort is on holiday.
