Forest School is London's only diamond structure school and is one of the very few in the country. This means that our 1400 boys and girls are taught separately at key stages of their education.

Surrounded by ancient forest, the School is located on the edge of Epping Forest in north east London.

The School Chamber Orchestra is an ensemble providing an opportunity for the most advanced string players from the Senior School to work together. The youngest members at present are 12 years old, and all year groups are represented in the orchestra. Wind players are added to enable us to perform Classical Symphonic and Concerto repertoire.

Many pupils at Forest achieve very high levels of musicianship and many go on to study music at university and conservatoire. In the orchestra today, Noeka Bradley (Y11) recently achieved a distinction in her ARSM Violin exam and Lucas Boardman (Y13) has won a scholarship place at the Royal College of Music in September to study French horn.
