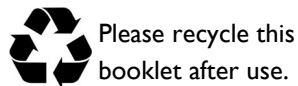

## Study Notes on the Sunday Gospel

### Readings for Trinity 10:

Isaiah 58.9b-14  
Psalm 103.1-8  
Luke 13.10-17

### Rejoicing at all the wonderful things that Jesus was doing ...

Today's readings have a massive emphasis on social justice as a key outcome of living Christian faith.

The prophet Isaiah in the First Reading speaks powerfully of the necessity of caring for the poor, of not judging others, of not serving our own interests as we are to be faithful.

The Psalm backs this up placing "justice for the oppressed" at the hearts of God's purpose—a God who is "merciful and gracious"

And in the Gospel God chooses to offend the leader of the synagogue by healing a crippled woman on the Sabbath—a day on which no work (including healing) is allowed. Jesus rebukes him first by pointing out that he is a hypocrite and secondly that the Sabbath was the perfect day to set someone free from 18 years of suffering. Release and rescue for the crippled, the marginalised and the needy at the very heart of the good news of Jesus Christ.
